- Students are met at the bus stop by the Area Arts building and accompanied back to GUMC.
- After checking in, students work on homework, read or select from station activities which strengthen memory verses, Bible themes and God's giftings.
- After stations, snacks are served and students will come together for a time of praise, prayer and community.
- Each week has a Bible story lesson, activity and memory verse.
- As opportunities present themselves, students also work on timely service projects and crafts for our churches, schools or the community.
- After our lesson and application time, students have free-play time with various activity choices.
- Students can be picked up at a time that works for the family, no later than 6 p.m.
